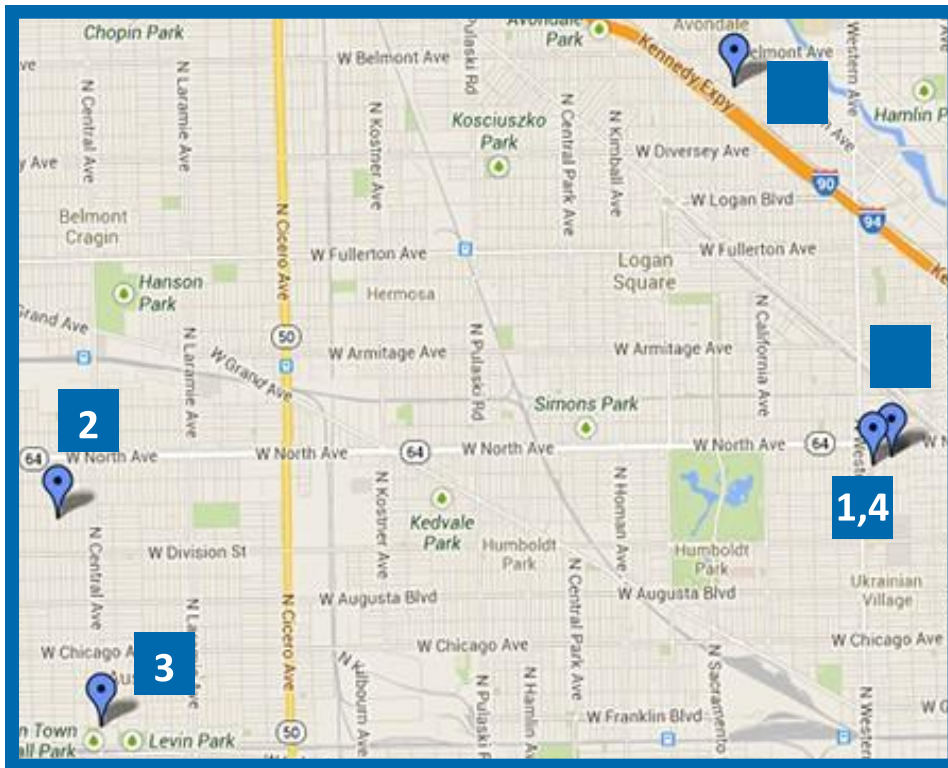

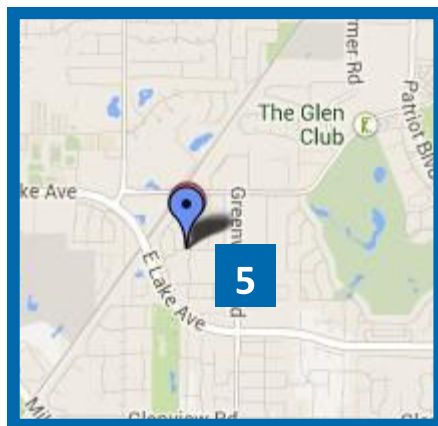

Description: The Teen Cohort runs for 9 weeks each year, 1 week during Spring Break, 2 weeks of Winter Break, and 6 weeks during Summer Break. Teens work during our seasonal camps at our program sites in Austin and Humboldt Park from 8am - 4pm each day, with one hour per day dedicated to leadership activities. Only 5 teens from each site can be paid, the rest are volunteers. To qualify for a paid position, a student must volunteer for two consecutive camps.

Description: The St. Joseph Services Youth Mentoring Program at St. Angela School is designed to mentor youth and assist their development of tools needed to have a bright and hopeful academic and employment future. Students will find a safe, nurturing environment that promotes education, peaceful conflict management, and positive behavior. The overall goal of the program is to increase academic success, college readiness, and job acquirement of our students through a comprehensive mentoring program.

Description: The St. Joseph Services Community Mentoring Internship (CMI) Program is a paid program for Josephinum Academy students to provide a pathway to a brighter future through training, employment, and mentoring, while also addressing internal barriers to success. Interns will have work hours designed to provide an introduction to different career opportunities. The goal of programming is to provide both an educational element of skills required to be successful, while also giving hands-on experience in working with children, adult education, or non-profit management. The CMI Program will serve as a first step into the world of employment and provides an opportunity for students to learn important practices such as dressing professionally, professional writing, goal setting, and handling conflict.
